Each child is to have one "Oh, No!" sign and one "Ah, Yes!" sign. Children will hold up the sign that is the best answer to the game question. For example: For the question, "Should we wash our hands before we eat?" Children should hold up their, Ah, Yes! signs. To expand the game, you can ask your child Oh, No! and Ah, Yes! questions. Or have your child ask you questions.

1. Should we share with our friends? (Ah, Yes!)
2. Do we run around while eating? (Oh, No!)
3. Should we make sure the adult who's taking care of us knows where we are? (Ah, Yes!)
4. Do we scream and cry when it's time for bed? (Oh, No!)
5. Should we say thank you when someone gives us something? (Ah, Yes!)
6. Do we hit our friends when we're mad at them? (Oh, No!)
7. Should we put our dirty clothes in the hamper? (Ah, Yes!)
8. Do we throw our wrappers on the ground? (Oh, No!)
9. Should we put our toys away when we are finished playing? (Ah, Yes!)
10. Do we throw our clean clothes on the floor? (Oh, No!)
11. Should we take turns with our friends? (Ah, Yes!)
12. Do we eat spaghetti with our hands? (Oh, No!)
13. Should we brush our teeth before going to bed? (Ah, Yes!)
14. Do we take things that belong to others? (Oh, No!)
15. Should we try new foods? (Ah, Yes!)
